Salary and Qualifications

Base pay after field training is \$61,075. To qualify for a police officer certification in Harker Heights, Texas, an applicant must meet all relevant entry level requirements. Some of which are that the candidate:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be at least 21 years of age
- Be a high school graduate or passed the GED test, if you have a GED, you must also have 12 college credits from an accredited college/university. Two years college, military, or law enforcement experience preferred.
- Possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license in the State of Texas.
- Never been arrested for any offense, or committed any act which would constitute perjury or false statement.
- Must have good credit history
