Youth soccer registration will begin May 27th. The season will start in September 2025.


Youth Basketball Camp (June 9-11, June 16-18, July 7-9, July 14-16) registration is open with limit availability.

The City issued zero (0) permits for two-family (duplex) residential construction within the month of April.

To date in calendar year 2025 (January 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025) the City has issued a total of forty-six (46) residential permits: twenty-one (29) new single-family permits, seventeen (17) new two-family permits, and zero (0) new multi-family permits.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

As of April 30, 2025, the estimated population for the City of Harker Heights is <u>36,067</u> residents. According to the US Census, the population as of April 1, 2020, was 33,097 residents. Since that time, we have added 1,000 new water accounts with an average household size of 2.97.
