COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT

The City issued **zero** (0) <u>new commercial</u> permits within the month of June.

To date in calendar year 2025 (January 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025) the City has issued a total of twelve (12) commercial permits: three (3) new commercial permits, and nine (9) commercial remodeling permits.

RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT

The City issued a total of **four (4)** permits for <u>single-family residential</u> construction within the month of June.

 - o Valued at \$814,586.00


The City issued **zero** (0) permits for <u>two-family</u> (duplex) <u>residential</u> construction within the month of June.

To date in calendar year 2025 (January 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025) the City has issued a total of fifty-four (58) residential permits: thirty-seven (41) new single-family permits, seventeen (17) new two-family permits, and zero (0) new multi-family permits.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

As of June 30, 2025, the estimated population for the City of Harker Heights is <u>36,076</u> residents. According to the US Census, the population as of April 1, 2020, was 33,097 residents. Since that time, we have added 1,003 new water accounts with an average household size of 2.97.
