

EXPANDED OPENINGS BY GOVERNOR ABBOTT – 9-17-2020

Governor Greg Abbott has announced the expanded re-openings only if a state hospital region of coronavirus hospitalizations is less than 15%. Only 3 regions do not meet that mark, Victoria, Laredo, and Lower Rio Grande Valley.

Starting Sept. 21 – industries that were limited to 50% are now expanded to 75%. Includes all retail stores, all restaurants, all office buildings, all manufacturing, all museums and libraries, and all gyms.

Hospitals in the approved regions may return to ordinary elective surgical procedures immediately.

Starting Sept. 24 – All nursing home facilities, assisted living centers, state supported living centers, and other long-term care facilities can reopen visitations.
