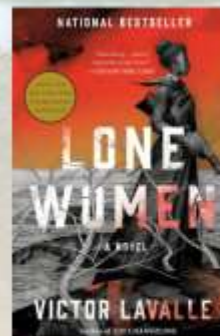

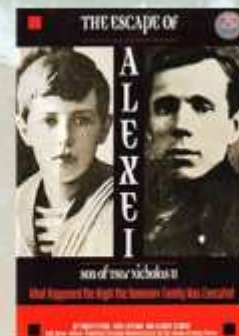

Important Reminder for All Harker Heights Residents!



As we approach Independence Day, we want to ensure everyone enjoys a safe and happy celebration. Please be reminded that discharging fireworks within the Harker Heights City Limits is illegal. Let's keep Harker Heights safe for everyone! Enjoy your celebration responsibly and thank you for helping us maintain a safe and peaceful community!



This ordinance is in place to protect our community from potential hazards.

The discharge of fireworks within the Harker Heights city limits is illegal per Chapter 130, Section 130.41 FINDINGS; PURPOSE, of the City of Harker Heights Code of Ordinances. A violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
