

Patient Protection Disclosures – Only applies to plans that require the designation of a primary care provider.

The City of Harker Heights generally requires the designation of a primary care provider. You have the right to designate any primary care provider who participates in our network and who is available to accept you or your family members. Until you make this designation, The City of Harker Heights designates one for you. For children, you may designate a pediatrician as the primary care provider.

You do not need prior authorization from The City of Harker Heights or from any other person (including a primary care provider) in order to obtain access to obstetrical or gynecological care from a health care professional in our network who specializes in obstetrics or gynecology. The health care professional, however, may be required to comply with certain procedures, including obtaining prior authorization for certain services, following a pre-approved treatment plan, or procedures for making referrals.
