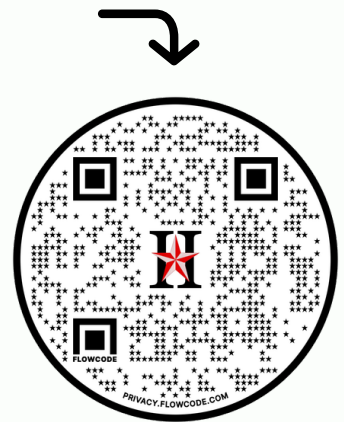

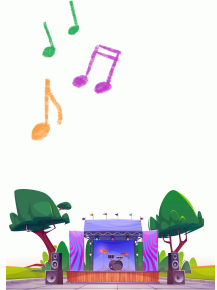

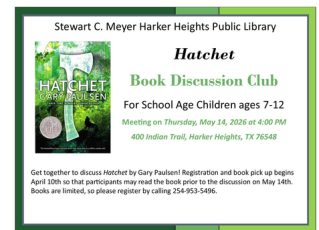
MOTHER'S DAY CRAFT WORKSHOP
