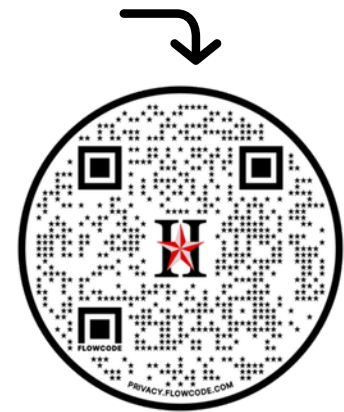

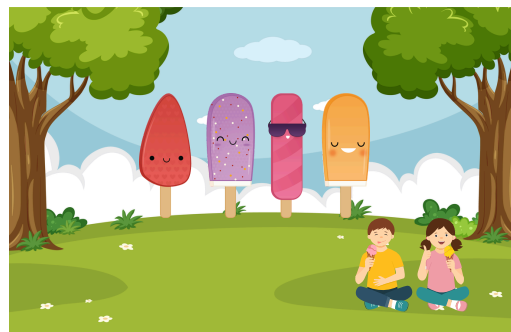
JULY IS PARK AND RECREATION MONTH

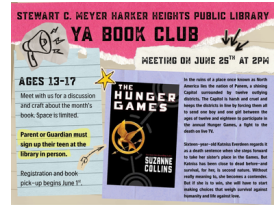
